AFTER A HARD-FOUGHT season, the last two rounds of the Toyo Tires Golf GTI Championship and the SuperPro VAG Trophy series saw the competition pick up considerably, writes John Hillon.

Silverstone (October 2-3) saw no less than 32 GTIs start for a 20-minute race around the GP (Bridge) circuit. Despite the shocking weather conditions, dark with heavy rain and spray, all finished unscathed, with James Bark (Class 2 16V) taking the win and newcomer

Clive Belton winning Class 1 (8V).

The final round at Snetterton (October 30-31) brought a double-header, with five competitors capable of winning the championship! A closely-fought pair of races were won by Simon Hill and James Bark respectively (Class 2), with a Class 1 win providing Craig Roberts with a back-to-back overall Golf GTI Championship win, by just 2 points!
